

Donor Recognition Program

A major component of St. Andrew's Place private support initiative is the Annual Campaign. This campaign recognizes family, friends, and supporting agencies who make annual contributions further the mission of St. Andrew's Place.

Membership in the St. Andrew's Place Partners and Fellows annual giving program is based upon calendar year giving (January 1 through December 31) renewed annually. Corporate matching gifts are included in the donor's gift total and membership can be held by an individual, husband and wife, a corporation, foundation, or organization.

History

St. Andrew's Place was established in 1973 as a ministry of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church by Fr. Francis Walter. The housing program was in response to the need for community residences for consumers leaving the state mental retardation system. Now as separate entity from the church, the agency continues to receive support from several area churches. St. Andrew's Place can accommodate over thirty individuals.

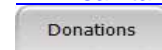
